


example SuperBowl, which was held in February and was followed by millions of people all over the world, the advertisements that appeared in the breaks were priceless.



The United States


In spite of American interest in sports, Not many people practice them, they prefer being sitting in the sofa, watching TV and eating.

The first year when Gasol played in the NBA he was the Rookie. which means that he was the best among the players who started playing that year. Now he is the most valuable player of his team.

Downtown or Under Manhattan

This area is situated in the South end of the island, in the oldest part of the city. In this part of the island we can find the New York Exchange Stock Market. This part of Manhattan is formed by districts or neighbourhoods, all of them have their own personality like Chinatown, Little Italy, Soho, Tribeca or Greenwich Village.

Midtown or Central Park

It is the most popular tourist zone in the area of New York, where the most popular landmarks are The Empire State Building, The Chrysler Building, The United Nations, The Rockefeller Center, The Terminal Central Grand or the theatre district of Broadway, these are some of the most visited places in New York. The streets of Midtown are perfectly designed in squares, the streets are numbered from south to north and the avenues from East so West. The Fifth Avenue divides the city in two great areas: East and West. Broadway is the only avenue that crosses the city in diagonal.



Uptown

Uptown is the North part of Manhattan from street 59. Upper East Side is the wealthiest in New York. It's the zone of the city with more museums.

Brooklyn is the most populated district of New York. In 1883, the bridge of Brooklyn city was opened. The most modern and revolutionary artists lived in low rent flats in this part of New York. Two important museums are in Brooklyn. The Children's Museum was the first museum of the world dedicated to children.


Gastronomy

In New York any time and any place is good for having something to eat. New York is full of food stalls where passers-by can buy any kind of take-away food, such as hot dogs, knishes, pretzels...

In addition to these food stalls, there are other places called DELIS where you can have both breakfast and lunch. Its seat is the Madison Square Garden and it's worth watching one of their matches

Rangers are the New York hockey team. The season goes from October to April.

<u>Marathon</u>: The most famous Marathon of the world is held every first Sunday of November. It begins in Staten Island and, after passing through the five districts, it finishes in Power station Park.

he Statue of Liberty National

Monument officially has celebrated
its 100th

birthday on October 28, 1986.

The people of France gave the Statue to the people of the United States one hundred years ago to commemorate the friendship between the two countries during the American Revolution. Over the years, the Statue of Liberty's symbolism has grown. Now, the statue is a symbol of freedom and democracy as well as of this international friendship.

Sculptor Frederic Auguste Bartholdi designed the sculpture to commemorate the centenary of the Independence of

American Declaration. The American people were to build the pedestal, and the French people were responsible for the Statue.

The pedestal was started in August 1885, and it was finished in April of 1886. The Statue was completed in France in July, 1884 and arrived in New York Harbor in June of 1885 on board of the French "Isere" which transported the Statue of Liberty from France to the United States. In transit, the Statue was reduced to 350 individual pieces and packed in 214 containers . The Statue was set up on its new pedestal in four months. On October 28th 1886, the dedication of the Statue of Liberty could be seen by thousands of spectators.

On the morning of September 11^{th} , 2001, the Statue of Liberty was closed because of safety and security. Liberty Island reopened to the public two months later but it was closed again. Finally, the Statue was opened again on August 3^{rd} , 2004.

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

the northwest of the state of Wyoming (United States) and it extends to the southwest of Montana and to the east of Idaho. It was created in 1872 and it's the biggest and the oldest national park in the United States. It has got an extension of 8983 km².

The park is situated in the heart of the Rocky Mountains and it's famous for its wonderful geysers (more than 3000), lots of thermal springs, waterfalls and . A 2440 metre tableland rises in the centre of the park, which is surrounded by steep mountains.

There are enormous forests, most of them covered with conifers, and they provide the animals a perfect habitat for their growth. Yellowstone's forests take up most of the territory (80%). The pine forest takes up kilometres and kilometres and is a major feature of this natural park. The fir forests lie in the hills, especially in the North of the park. The Whitebark pine is Grizzlies' main source of food. The bears migrate to the Whitebark pine areas, like the Mt. Washburn, in autumn. Moose and bison graze in the valleys, like Hayden and Lamar.

Yellowstone is considered one of the most significant aquatic ecosystems in the United States because it has about 220 lakes. Now, about 40 lakes have fish thanks to restokings. The park is one of the most important wild animal reserves. Only the species that can endure the hard living conditions of the park survive here. The grizzly bear, the moose, the antelope, the American moose, the bison, the lynx and the otter are the species that live there. The eagle, the pelican and the trumpet swan are three of the 200 bird species. Also, there are lots of amphibian and reptile species, the black bear variety, grey wolves and the mountain goats.

The Yellowstone weather is unpredictable. It could be warm and sunny with high temperatures in a summer day; whereas, temperatures could go down extremely at any moment.

The fire has represented one of the big dangers to animals and plants. Reports say that lightning cause about 22 fires a year. The plants, the biggest Yellowstone ecosystem, have adapted to the fire and in some cases, their survival depends on the area where they grow.

Los Angeles

L. A. is a city in the southwest of the United States, in the State of California. The Spanish founded it in 1781. It was the Californian capital under the Mexican power (1835 – 1846). There are 2,816,000 habitants. 40% are South Americans, 14% Afro-american and the 10% Asian. The metropolitan area, includes the satellite cities of Anaheim, Glendale, Pasadena and Long Beach, it is situated on the Pacific Ocean's shore. It has a subtropical climate. It occupies 10,000 $\rm Km^2$. Nearby, there are beautiful and crowded beaches (Santa Monica, Long Beach, Santa Barbara). It is often struck with earthquakes. It is also a polluted city and fires are common.

Hollywood is the principal centre of the world for movies and television.

It's the first city to provide flowers to the United States. The tourism is important for the economy of the city. It's also important the aeronautic industry. In addition, there are oil refineries, automobile industries, canned food and machinery industries. It has some universities too. Disneyland Theme Park and a modern aquarium called Marinelandia. In the L. A. State History Park there is a zoo and the planetarium. Other interesting places are the Culture and Art Museum, Armand Hammer, the Historic Society Centre of California, the Southwest Museum (it has American Indian objects), the Contemporanean Art Museum designed by Isozoky Arata (a Japanese arquitect). The Central Public Library, with 2.1 millions books, is one of the best in the country. The Farmers' Market (an outdoor bazaar with shops and restaurants) is very popular. There also are some famous neighbourhoods such as , Chinatown, Little Tokyo and Burbank.

Hollywood

Hollywood is an independent district of Los Angeles. It's famous for being the centre of the film and TV industry of this country. It attracts thousands of tourists each year. Its main avenues are Sunset Boulevard, Hollywood Boulevard and Vine Street, where there are some famous restaurants, night-clubs and recording studios. Hollywood Bowl, a natural amphitheatre located in the surrounding hills, iss a stage for numerous cultural events. The favourable climatic conditions and the variety of sceneries encouraged many people to set up their businesses there. It was created at the end of the decade of 1880. First, it was a ranch (The Holly), then it became a town and finally, in 1910 it annexed to L. A. The first recording studio was established by Centaur Film. It has been the movie capital for more than 50 years.


tol is the building of National Files.

The library Folger Shakespeare possesses the biggest collection in the world of works written by William Shakespeare.



ast summer, during the month of July, I spent ten days in Belgium with a group of people aged Infrom 18 to 40. It was the European festival which started eleven years ago, and whose first contest took place in the same Belgian village, Libramont. Since then, it has been celebrated every year in a village of the fourteen European components (Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Scotland).
